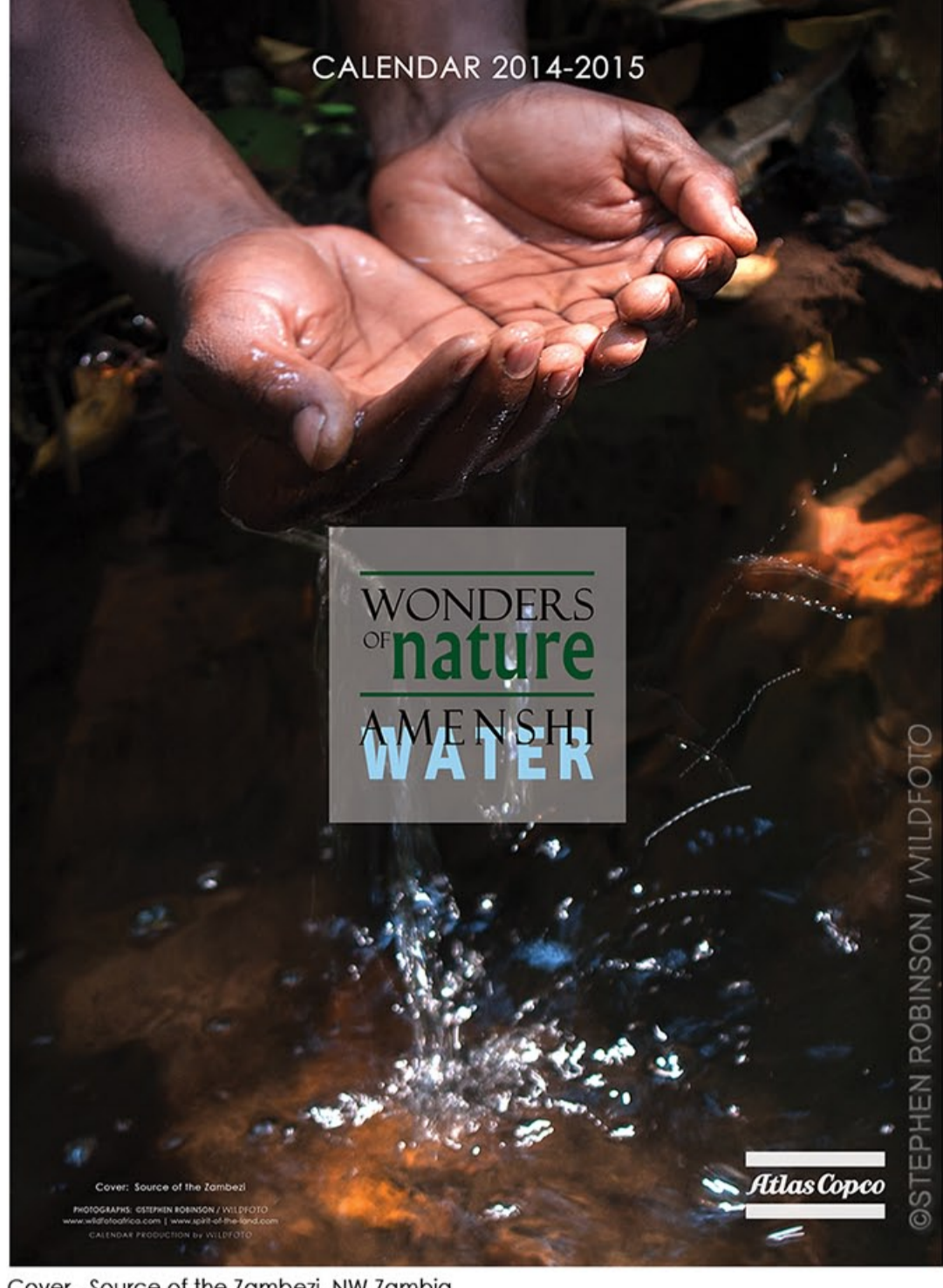

The Story Behind the Pictures: Wonders of Nature Calendar 2014-2015: Amenshi (Water)

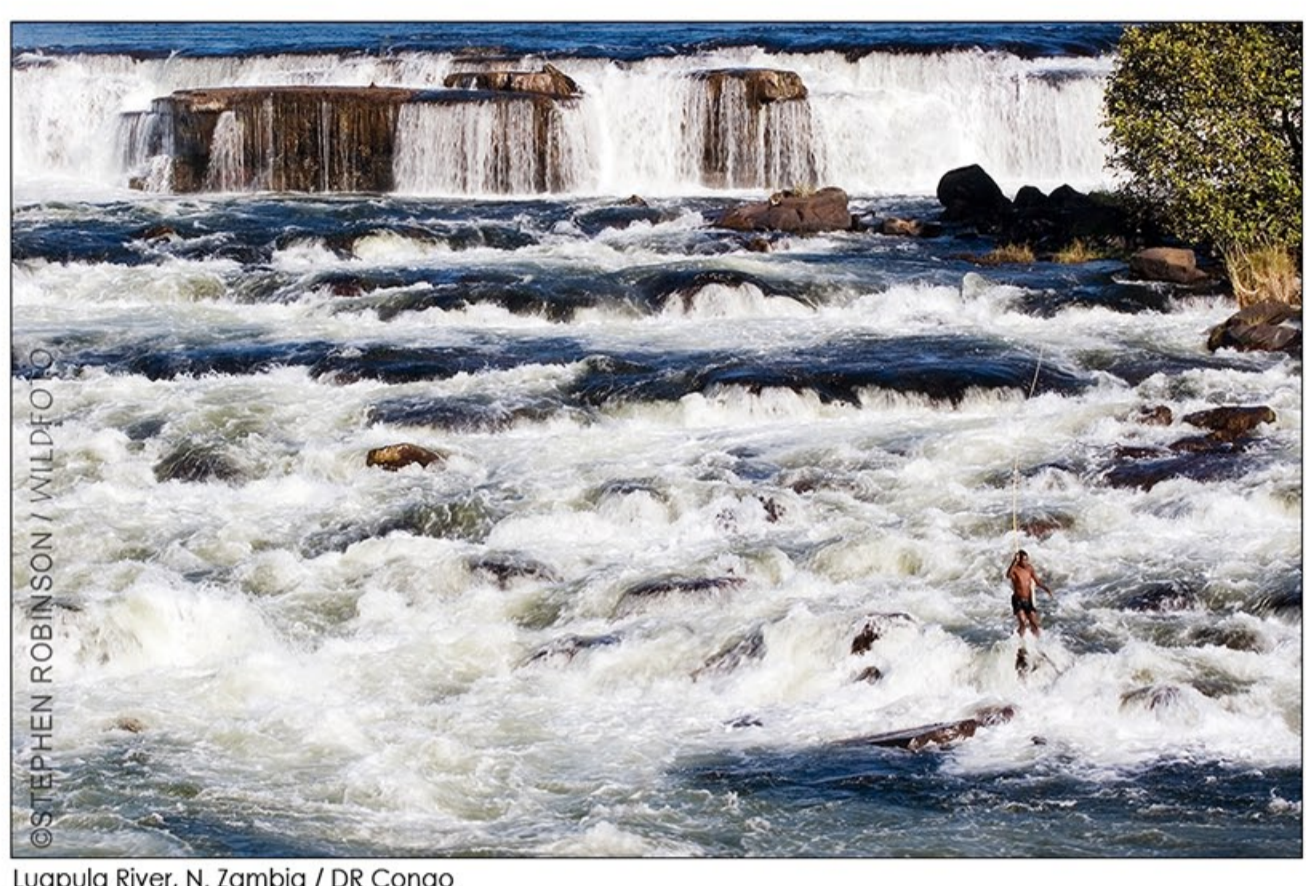

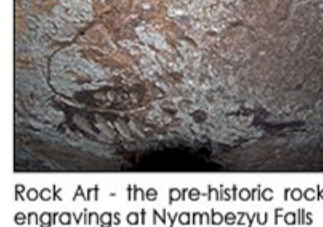

The Nyambwezu Falls are situated at the a pre-historic rock shelter / cave site which is designated a National Monument. The rock shelter is situated at the top left of this photograph and contains rock engravings which are now largely obscured (see inset at left). But the falls and the river gorge below are definitely worth a visiting and exploring.

Venturing out into the river course in this area, even at low water, is a dangerous pastime. The Zambezi River frequently surges 1 to 2m or more in depth, often sweeping people downstream and over the edge of the falls into the jaws of the gorge some 100m below.
