In this PhotoMail, we look at the vain art of the instant self portrait.


The Brandenburg Gate in Berlin is very much the symbol of both German reunification and of Europe itself. So


were there only in the cause of Vanity - to get that Selfie portrait to send to their pals on Fussbook, to say: "I was










Selfie Tip 6: Ask for help
